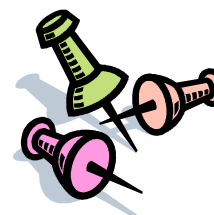
#### Hello La Luz!

### Professional Development Committee Report April 2010

#### La Luz Lamplighter Newsletter Wins District Newsletter Award in Reno! Yea!

Our applicant for the SBMEF Grant, Sarina Turnbull, has been awarded a \$2000 grant for the coming school year. La Luz Chapter received five applications for the SBMEF Grant. Sarina is invited to attend any of our remaining chapter meetings to receive her award.

The chapter provided three of those applications to Albuquerque Charter Chapter, who is awarding 3 special scholarships in the amount of \$2000. The other applicant is attending an out-of-state university and is ineligible for the Albuquerque Charter Chapter awards. The chapter in Lubbock, where she will be attending college, has already made an SBMEF Grant award.

Professional development opportunities in our chapter notebook include:

### SBMEF Business Skills Tuition Reimbursement

#### Qualification

- Max Per fiscal year one half (1/2) of the tuition up \$500
- Minimum per reimbursement \$50
- Must attend a licensed, accredited or state-approved institution in the United States or its possessions, territories, or districts
- Female US Citizen
- Does not need to be a member of ABWA

#### Process

1. Submit application within 90 days of attending the course. Include:
  - c. course description
  - d. rationale for attendance
  - e. verification of the institution's or organization's credentials

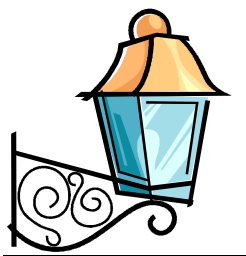
### Outright Grants Program Qualifications

- Max Per fiscal year \$1,500
- Funds are to be used only for tuition, books and fees.
- Female US Citizen
- Must be at least at the sophomore level in college (completed 45 credit hours) applying for funds to be used the following year.
- Does not need to be a member of ABWA
- Have a 2.5 or better GPA on a 4.0 scale
- Must be seeking a baccalaureate degree or higher

#### Process

1. Complete the candidate information section of the SBMEF application in full.
2. Provide official transcripts of grades from all colleges attended.
3. Write a one-page biographical summary
4. Submit three current letters of reference from persons other than relatives.

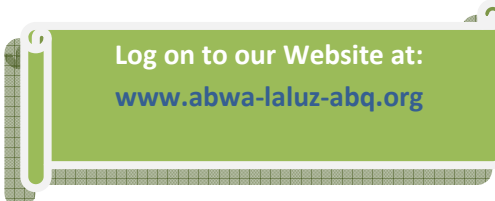
