Hello La Luz!

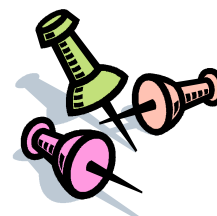

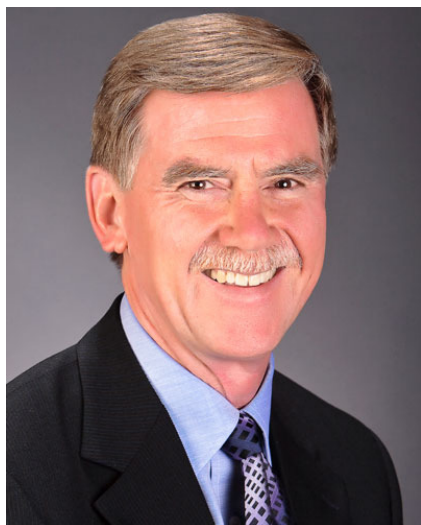

“Ask and Listen not Tell and Sell” How to Effectively Reach People in the 21st Century.

Key highlights from presentation:

-Sales process to organize toward what you want to accomplish.

-Little decisions make a big difference in your life.

-Doing things you don't really want to do builds character.

-Focus on end result. It's a measurable, pre-calculated strategy.

-Sales process:

>Use philosophy to figure out why the customer would want your product.

>You ask questions and listen for answers. I.D. the questions that go with your product.

>Example of questions at Z-Coil:

How did you hear about us? Have you ever see Z-Coil before?

Do you have any foot, leg, or back pain?

(Get focus away from the product and onto the person.)

How long have you been dealing with that?

What are you doing so far?

-This process connects the customer with your product.

-You then explain the product attributes and what the product will do for them.

-Share a story of success of those using the product.

 - a. course description
 - b. rational for attendance
 - c. date, time and location of class
2. Professional Development committee will vote on approval, requires a majority vote
3. Applicant will be notified of approval
4. After attending the class:
 - a. submit a written report for publication in the newsletter
 - b. receipt

SBMEF Business Skills Tuition Reimbursement

Qualification

- Max Per fiscal year one half (1/2) of the tuition up \$500
- Minimum per reimbursement \$50
- Must attend a licensed, accredited or state-approved institution in the United States or its possessions, territories, or districts
- Female US Citizen
- Does not need to be a member of ABWA

Process

1. Submit application within 90 days of attending the course. Include:
 - c. course description
 - d. rational for attendance
 - e. verification of the institution's or organization's credentials

Outright Grants Program Qualifications

- Max Per fiscal year \$1,500
- Funds are to be used only for tuition, books and fees.
- Female US Citizen
- Must be at least at the sophomore level in college (completed 45 credit hours) applying for funds to be used the following year.
- Does not need to be a member of ABWA
- Have a 2.5 or better GPA on a 4.0 scale
- Must be seeking a baccalaureate degree or higher

Process

1. Complete the candidate information section of the SBMEF application in full.
2. Provide official transcripts of grades from all colleges attended.
3. Write a one-page biographical summary
4. Submit three current letters of reference from persons other than relatives.
